Emergency Closures

It may be necessary because of threat of severe weather or other emergency to send students home from school early.

Accordingly, the following procedures will be followed:

- 1. If, for any reason, the students should be sent home early because of an impending emergency, every effort will be made to contact parents of K-6 students or their emergency contact;
- 2. If any emergency (wind, flood, earthquake, etc.) should strike suddenly, the matter of departure of students from school will be decided by the superintendent in consultation with the Principals. This decision may be to send student(s) home immediately; it may be to keep them in the schools indefinitely under continued supervision until the emergency has passed. Whatever the decision, it will be with the best interest of student(s) as to the determining factor;
- 3. In case of any emergency, please turn your radio/television to local stations for information concerning the release of student(s) from school;
- 4. If the decision is made to keep the students in their respective schools, they may be picked up at the school by checking at the school's office;
- 5. Some circumstances may require school opening to be delayed one to two hours which would mean bus schedules would be one to two hours late.
