Instructional Goal

- 5. Provides opportunities for students to learn, think, reason, retrieve information, use technology and work effectively alone and in groups;
- 6. Provides for rigorous academic content standards and instruction in mathematics, science, history, geography, economics, civics, physical education, health, the arts and second languages;
- 7. Provides students with an educational background to the end that they will function successfully in a constitutional republic, a participatory democracy and a multi cultural nation and world;
- 8. Provides students with the knowledge and skills that will provide the opportunities to succeed in the world of work, as members of families and as citizens;
- 9. Provides students with the knowledge, skills and positive attitude that lead to an active, healthy lifestyle;
- 10. Provides students with the knowledge and skills to take responsibility for their decisions and choices;
- 11. Provides opportunities for students to learn through a variety of teaching strategies;
- 12. Emphasizes involvement or parents and community in the total education of students and encourages student engagement in learning activities that involve the community and its resources;
- 13. Provides career emphasis at all grades in an effort to make education more relevant;

- 14. Provides an opportunity for teaching manners and character;
- 15. Transports students safely to and from school;
- 16. Ensures that the funds allocated to schools reflect the uncontrollable differences in costs facing each district;
- 17. Ensures that local schools have adequate control of how funds are spent to best meet the needs of students in their communities; and
- 18. Provides for a safe, educational environment.
