IMMUNIZATIONS, HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS OF STUDENTS

Proof of immunization must be presented prior to the time of initial enrollment in school or within 30 days of transfer to the district. Proof consists of a signed "Certificate of Immunization Status" form documenting either evidence of immunization or a religious and/or medical exemption. The Board recommends that all students initially enrolling in school have a physical examination. Parents will be asked to complete a district "Health History" form when initially enrolling their children in the district.

Beginning with the sixth grade and continuing on through grade 12, students wishing to participate in extracurricular athletic program must have a physical examination at least every other year.

The physical examination must be performed by a professional that is licensed by the State Board Of Medical Examiners.

The physical examination must be completed and registered with the student's school prior to participation in practice or competition.

Example: If a student has a physical in the sixth grade, they do not need another physical examination until the eighth grade. If a student has a physical examination their sophomore year then their next physical examination will occur their senior year.

Record of the examination shall be kept on file at school and shall be reviewed by the coach prior to the start of any sport season. Students shall not participate without a record of passing the examination
