Directory Information**

Directory information is information contained in a student education record which is not generally considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if released. The following categories are designated as directory information. The following directory information may be released to the public through appropriate procedures:

- 1. Student's name;
- 2. Date and place of birth;
- 3. Participation in officially recognized sports and activities;
- 4. Weight and height of athletic team members;
- 5. Dates of attendance;
- 6. Degrees or awards received;
- 7. Most recent previous school or program attended;
- 8. Student's address;
- 9. Student's telephone listing;
- 10. Student's electronic address;
- 11. Student's photograph;
- 12. Major field of study.

Public Notice

The district will give annual public notice to parents of students in attendance and students 18 years of age or emancipated. The notice shall identify the types of information considered to be directory information, the district's option to release such information and the requirement that the district must, by law, release secondary students' names, addresses and telephone numbers to military recruiters and/or institutions of higher education, unless parents or eligible students request the district withhold this information. Such notice will be given prior to release of directory information.

Exclusions

Exclusions from any or all directory categories names as directory information or release of information to military recruiters and/or institutions of higher education must be submitted in writing to the principal by the parent, student 18 years of age or emancipated student within 15 days of annual public notice.

Directory information shall be released only with administrative direction.

At no point will a student's Social Security Number or student identification number be considered directory information.

Directory information considered by the district to be detrimental will not be released.

Information will not be given over the telephone except in health and safety emergencies.
