**Relations with Law Enforcement Agencies**

It is the intent of the Board to maintain a cooperative relationship with law enforcement agencies. Law officers' presence and participation in school programs are encouraged to promote a positive attitude by students toward police.

Whenever a law officer wishes to confer with or question a student at the school, the principal or his/her designee shall be present at the meeting and an effort will be made to contact the parent/guardian-custodian so that the responsible adult may be notified of the situation.

A student may be removed from school by a law officer or an authorized representative of the Oregon Department of Human Services.

Outside agencies may deliver subpoenas and warrants to students in the presences of an administrator.
