



Systematic ELD pull-out is the time of day when English learners learn how English works and acquire a solid foundation in English by learning the language they:

- ✓ Are not likely to learn outside of school or efficiently pick up on their own.
- ✓ Will not be explicitly taught in other subject areas.
- ✓ Need to be able to use every day for effective academic learning and classroom participation.

Systematic ELD supports content-area success by strengthening language skills and teaching the language that native-English speakers already bring to their schooling.

It follows a scope and sequence of language skills with a focus on the high-leverage, portable vocabulary and sentences structures of the proficiency levels.
